

Incentive Measures for Student Self-Governing Organizations and Associations to Participate in Off-Campus Competitions (NCHU)

Approved at the Student Affairs Meeting on June 15, 2006 for the second semester of the 94th school year

Article 1 National Chung Hsing University (hereinafter referred to as "NCHU") has established the Incentive Measures for Student Self-Governing Organizations and Associations to Participate in Off-Campus Competitions (hereinafter referred to as "Measures") to encourage student self-governing organizations and associations to participate in off-campus competitions, to demonstrate the achievements of extracurricular activities, and to actively strive for honors.

Article 2 The Measures are to award prizes to students who participate in national or international competitions organized or commissioned by government agencies in the name of NCHU through the Extracurricular Group and who have not been awarded prizes.

International competitions refer to those held by various countries and in which an average of more than four countries have participated in each category in the past three years, excluding exhibition competitions, invitational competitions, and observation competitions.

Article 3 To apply for an award in accordance with the Measures, associations shall fill out the "Award Application Form for the Participation of Student Self-governing Organizations and Associations in Extracurricular Competitions (NCHU)" and submit it to the Extracurricular Group from April 1 to April 30 or October 1 to October 31 of each year, attached with the proof of approved participation, proof of the number of participating teams, documentation of participation, and proof of awards.

Article 4 If the student self-governing organizations of NCHU have won the first three places (or the first six places if the number of participating teams exceeds 20) in national or international competitions and have been approved by the Extracurricular Group, they will be awarded in the following manner.

- (1) Individual group: NT\$ 10,000 for the first place, NT\$ 8,000 for the second place, NT\$ 7,000 for the third place, NT\$ 6,000 for the fourth place, and NT\$ 5,000 for the fifth place, and NT\$ 4,000 for the sixth place.
- (2) Small group (within eight members): NT\$ 16,000 for the first place, NT\$ 12,000 for the second place, NT\$ 8,000 for the third place, NT\$ 7,000 for the fourth place, and NT\$ 6,000 for the fifth place, and NT\$ 5,000 for the sixth place.
- (3) Large group (more than nine members): NT\$ 48,000 for the first place, NT\$ 36,000 for the second place, NT\$ 24,000 for the third place, NT\$ 21,000 for the fourth place, and NT\$ 18,000 for the fifth place, and NT\$ 15,000 for the sixth place.

The bonuses stipulated in the preceding paragraphs may be adjusted according to the number of participating teams, namely, multiply by 0.2 times for 1-3 teams; multiply by 0.4 times for 4-8 teams; multiply by 0.6 times for 9 to 16 teams; multiply by 0.8 times for 17 to 32 teams; multiply by 1 time for more than 32 teams.

If it is an international competition, it will be multiplied by 3 times after adjusting the ratio according to the number of participating teams.

The first award includes the equivalent of each ranking.

Article 5 The self-governing organization and association may apply for group and individual awards up to a maximum of NT\$ 100,000 per year. The bounty received shall be used for the operation of the organization and association.

Article 6 Students who have won prizes in the competition will be nominated for awards by the counseling unit in accordance with the Student Award Regulations of NCHU.

Article 7 The award shall be covered by the NCHU's student public funds and scholarships.

Article 8 After the Measures are reviewed and approved by the Student Affairs Meeting, they will be presented to the principal for approval and implementation, and the same applies to amendments.
