

Key Points for the Establishment of the Student Association Review Committee (NCHU)

Approved at the Student Affairs Meeting on March 18, 2015 in the second semester of the 103rd school year
Amended at the Student Affairs Meeting on June 4, 2018 in the second semester of the 106th school year (Articles 1 and 2)
Amended at the Student Affairs Meeting on May 15, 2020 in the second semester of the 108th school year (Articles 1-3, 5-7)

1. To improve the operation of the student associations of NCHU, the Key Points for the Establishment of the Student Association Review Committee (hereinafter referred to as "Key Points") have been formulated in accordance with the first paragraph of Article 4 of the Organization and Guidance Measures of Student Associations.
2. The tasks of the Student Association Review Committee (hereinafter referred to as the "Committee"):
 - (1) Review the formal establishment, dissolution, revocation, and abolition of student associations.
 - (2) Review the appointment qualifications of student association instructors.
 - (3) Review the other important matters of associations.
3. The Committee consists of the Director of Office of Student Affairs, the Deputy Director of Office of Student Affairs, the leader of the Extracurricular Activities Group, two members of the Extracurricular Activities Group, one administrative instructor recommended by the Extracurricular Activities Group, the head of the association of the Student's Union, and the top four association presidents who have won the Special Award in the student association evaluation in the current year (if they are unable to serve for some reason, they will be replaced according to their ranking).
4. The association shall hold the meeting once a semester, and may convene interim meetings when necessary. When the meeting is held, the convener shall serve as the chairman. When the convener cannot attend the meeting, the convener shall designate a member to serve as the chairman.
5. Regarding the abolition of student associations, except for those that voluntarily apply for dissolution, proposals shall be submitted by members and signed by three members before review. The Committee may notify the person in charge (representative) of the association or the instructor to attend for inquiries as needed.
6. The meeting shall be convened only when two-thirds (inclusive) or more of all members are present, and the resolution shall be approved by more than one-half of the members present.
7. The Key Points shall be promulgated and implemented after approval by the Director of the Office of Student Affairs, and the same applies to amendment.
