1-2	General household waste (recyclable)	To be collected by recycling trucks at fixed times and locations <u>on Tuesdays and Fridays from 8:20 AM to 10:43 AM:</u> (1) ❶Paper food containers, ❷glass food containers, ❸tin cans, ❹aluminum cans, ❺plastic bottles, ❻recyclable soft plastic covers, ❼recyclable plastics, and ❽other recyclable items are collected on Tuesdays (please see Table 2 for sorting instructions). (2) ❶Food containers and ❷paper items are collected on Fridays. ※Note: Food containers should be cleaned properly with no leftover scraps or liquids.																								
1-3	General household tempered glass items	Please retain for collection at the times and locations announced before Lunar New Year during the annual Taichung Cleanup Month																								
1-4	General household pottery and ceramics	Please retain for collection at the times and locations announced before Lunar New Year during the annual Taichung Cleanup Month																								
2-1	Post-lab liquid waste	The lab/trial manager should report waste online before the 10th of each month then print out, sign, and turn in the form to the Center before the 12 th for outsourced waste managers.																								
2-2	Post-lab hazardous industrial waste	1. Hazardous industrial waste from laboratories (discarded needles, syringes, microbial Petri dishes, bacterial strains, and other related bioproducts) must be collected by a qualified waste manager as per the <i>Waste Disposal Act</i> . 2. 		hazardous industrial waste transporters every Friday : (1) To avoid injury, place discarded needles and syringes in a hard impenetrable container made of a thick plastic material with a sealable lid. Please ensure no needles are protruding and the container can be kept upright and stable during use. 	<p>(1) Count the number of abandoned bikes occupying campus grounds that need to be disposed of.</p> <p>(2) Pick up disposal notice stickers for abandoned bikes on campus grounds at the Center.</p> <p>(3) Write the correct information on each sticker, stamp it with the official seal, then apply them to the bikes.</p> <p>(4) A public notice for owners to remove or dispose of their bikes within the prescribed period shall be visibly posted in that very building to avoid future disputes.</p> <p>(5) Register the number of bikes with notices posted on the online platform: https://safety.nchu.edu.tw/web/waste_bicycle.php?bar=3.</p> <p>(6) Count and fill in the number of bikes again after the period ends.</p> <p>2. Upon receiving final confirmation from each unit, the Center will remove bikes based on reports as per the <i>Waste Disposal Act</i>.</p>	<p><u>Those who arbitrarily discard general household garbage on campus will be reported to the Taichung Environmental Protection Bureau and fined as per Article 50 of the <i>Waste Disposal Act</i>.</u></p>
