貳、 抽籤申請暨結果選填說明

- 一、 凡本校在籍學生(惟循環經濟學院學生除外)(含大學部舊生、碩博班舊生、延畢生、在職專班舊生) 皆可申請床位抽籤(特殊生床位申請敬請另行參閱特殊生床位申請公告),線上床位系統路徑如下:
- (一)床位抽籤申請路徑:與大入口單一簽入系統→各系統入口:學務資訊系統→學生宿舍:宿舍床位抽籤/申請。
- (二)床位抽籤結果公告暨床位確認路徑:興大入口單一簽入系統→各系統入口:學務資訊系統→學生宿舍:床位公告/確認住宿。

二、流程說明

- (一)自112學年度起,學生宿舍開放申請時,同學僅須至線上系統登記抽籤,舊生進入「宿舍床位抽籤/申請」系統後,請依流程點檢視宿舍各項資訊及規定並點選「同意」鍵後,即可完成抽籤申請。
- (二)自112學年度起,床位中籤者可任選開放棟別及房號,若欲同住者,可先共同討論欲選擇之房號, 於系統開放選填時同步選取,並請依下列注意事項辦理:
 - 1. 第一階段、第二階段床位抽籤結果公告期間,中籤者請務必上網選取自己住宿棟別及房號, 選取確認後即獲得113學年度(含上下學期及寒假)床位。若中籤者未選取住宿棟別及房號,視 為放棄床位。未上網選取者視同放棄床位,宿舍不再分配床位,不得異議。
 - 2. 第一、二階段床位中籤者,系統將E-mail通知至中籤者學校公務信箱(與大入口單一簽入系統→各系統入口:郵件系統),此僅提醒通知,不得以未收到E-mail而宣稱權益受損,敬請同學仍須主動上網查看結果並自行選取棟別及房號。
 - 3. 第一階段未中籤者則顯示"本階段未中籤",其申請資料將直接進入第二階段抽籤作業。第二階段未中籤者則顯示"本階段未中籤",仍須住宿者可另申請線上床位候補,詳情另參見住輔組網頁4月下旬之線上候補申請公告。
 - 4. 若因個人疏失未於規定時間內進行選取或放棄者,導致個人權益受損或須繳納手續費、扣繳 宿費,恕不負責。
 - 5. 第一、二階段中籤者若無須住宿,請務必不要選取棟別及房號,若已選取欲放棄者最遲須於 5月20日(含)前至男/女宿、二村服務中心辦理放棄床位手續(請繳交床位放棄聲明書及身份證件影本),未於期限內放棄床位者將視為確定住宿,並產生住宿相關費用,隨附於學雜費單中繳納,不得異議。逾期放棄床位者將依《住宿輔導辦法》第十四條規定扣繳費用,不得異議,亦不得以任何理由要求校方變更扣繳之宿費。

- (二)參加住宿申請的同學即視為已同意中興大學住宿輔導辦法、男生宿舍/興大二村/女生宿舍公約及違規處理要點...等相關規定,如有異議請勿申請住宿。

- (四)未中籤但仍有住宿意願者,可參加5月23日(四)之空床位候補申請,相關事宜將於4月下旬於本 組首頁公告。

SECOND STAGE [ONLINE ROOM SELECTION]	April 19 th (Fri) 10am April 21 th (Sun) 5pm	 Successful applicants in second stage must select their room online to confirm their accommodation during the system opening's hours. If not, they are deemed to have given up the application. Unsuccessful applicants in second stage want to live in the dorm shall apply the bed waiting list application online (Please refer to the announcement of the online waiting list application).
RESULT ANNOUNCEMENT OF BED ALLOCATION	April 24 th (Wed) 10am April 25 th (Thu) 5pm	 For those who have selected the building and room numbers in the past two stages, please check the result of the room and the bed allocation during the system's opening hours. For those who want to check the result beyond the opening hours, please contact our Dormitory Service Center.
CANCELLATION OF BEDS	Before May 20 th (Mon) 5pm	 Those who want to give up their beds must submit a written application to the Dormitory Service Center and do not need to pay any fees before 5pm on May 20th, 2024. A handling fee of TWD 1,000 is required for those who give up their beds during the period from May 21th to August 25th, 2024. Those who give up their beds after August 26th, 2024 will be charged for partial accommodation fee according to the Article 14 of NCHU Dormitory Regulations. Remarks: The date (August 25th) is set for 14 days before the first school day of the semester (September 9th) according the rule and will be adjusted if the date of the first day is changed.

II. Instructions for getting the bed through drawing lots:

1. All current students (excluding students of Academy of Circular Economy) (including non-freshmen of bachelor's, master's, and doctoral programs, deferred graduates, and non-freshmen of in-service programs) are eligible to apply for beds (for special students, please refer to the bed application notice for special students).

The online system for beds is as shown below:

- (1)Application path for getting the bed: NCHU Single Sign On System→ ALL Application Entry: Student Affairs Information→ Student Dormitory: Students' Dorm Application.
- (2)The announcement of the results of getting beds and the bed confirmation: NCHU Single Sign On System→ ALL Application Entry→ Student Affairs Information: Student Dormitory: Bed Announcement/Confirmation.

2. Instructions:

(1)Starting from the 112th academic year, when the dormitory is open for application, students can register online to apply for their beds. After entering the system "Students' Dorm Application", non-freshmen need to click on the "Agree" button to the related dorm information and read all the regulations to complete the application.

(2)Starting from the 112th academic year, those who get a bed in the drawing lot can select their building and room numbers online, and may discuss with whom they want to live together the room number and then select the room simultaneously when the system is open for selection. Please obey the following matters.

- A. During the announcement of the results of getting beds through drawing lots in Stage 1 and 2, those who get a bed shall select their building and room number online. This selection is the confirmation of the bed, then students will be allocated a bed for 113th academic year (including the first semester, winter vacation, and the second semester). Those who do not select building and room numbers online will be deemed to give up their beds and will not be allocated a bed, and no objection is allowed.
- B. For those who get a bed in Stage 1 and 2, the system will notify them via official Email (NCHU Single Sign On System→ ALL Application Entry→ Email). Students must check the results of drawing lots online and choose the building and room number by themselves. E-MAIL is only a reminder. Claiming that you did not receive the Email afterwards as an excuse to request compensation is not allowed.
- C. For those who do not get a bed in Stage 1, their application materials will be directly used for Stage 2. Those who do not get a bed in Stage 2 and want to live in a dorm shall apply for beds in the waiting list online (for details, please refer to the announcement of the online waiting list application on the website of the Division of Student Housing Service in late April).
- D. If students fail to select or give up their beds within the stipulated time due to personal negligence, the Division of Student Housing Service will not be liable for the damage to their rights and interests, the payment of handling fees, or the withholding of dormitory fees.
- E. For those who have obtained a bed in Stage 1 and Stage 2 and no longer need the accommodation, please do not select the building and the room number. For those who have selected the building and room numbers but want to give up their bed, they shall go to the Male/Female/Second-Village Dormitory Service Center to go through the formalities of giving up the bed before May 20th by submitting the Statement of Giving Up the Bed, together with a photocopy of the ID card. Those who do not give up their beds within the time limit are deemed to live in the dorm, and they shall pay accommodation-related fees as tuition and miscellaneous fees without objection. Those who give up their beds after the deadline will be charged according to Article 14 of the Dormitory Regulations of National Chung Hsing University, and no objection shall be allowed, and the students shall not request the school to change any withholding fee for any reason.

3. Precautions:

- (1) For information about each dormitory area, please refer to the website of the Division of Student Housing Service.
- (2) Those who apply for dormitory beds through drawing lots are deemed to agree to the Dormitory Regulations of National Chung Hsing University, Guidelines on Rules and Punishment for Male/Female/Second-Village Dormitory, and other relevant laws and regulations. Please do not apply for accommodation if you have any objections.
- (3) The opening date of the 113th academic year for each grade of students will be announced separately on the 'Latest News' website of the Division of Student Housing Service
- (4) Those who fail to get the beds but want to live in the dorm can participate in the waitlist application for vacant beds on May 23th. Relevant matters will be announced on
