NCHU Student Guidelines for Implementing School Assembly

Pass by students affairs meeting dated June. 20, 2008 Amended by students affairs meeting dated October. 23, 2015 Amended by students affairs meeting dated December. 1, 2017

- In general, the School Assembly is held once each semester (the date will be announced). The meeting will be held by NCHU President. All undergraduate freshmen mustattend. Deans of Academic Affairs, General Affairs, Student Affairs, Research & Development, and Colleges shall participate. Aside from the week meeting, collegedean, department chair, mentor, and office of student affairs can host othermeetings when necessary. The colleges can set the dates of the meeting and formulate implementing regulations.
- $2 \cdot \text{Dress}$ neatly and properly for the meeting by following NCHU regulations.
- 3 Attend the meeting on time. Class leaders are responsible for calling the roll.
- 4 During the meeting, order disturbing, reading, boos, and noise making are prohibited.
- All NCHU students must attend the school assembly as required. Extra 1 point will be added to the conduct grade of a compliant participant. No extra points will be given to students who are absent after requesting for leave. 2 points are deducted from the conduct grade for students who miss a meeting without proper reasons.
- 6 The present provision and any amendments shall be implemented after being passed by Student Affairs Meeting and approved by NCHU President.
