NCHU Student Conduct Evaluation Regulation

Amended by students affairs meeting dated March 12, 2013 Amended by students affairs meeting dated April 28, 2017

- Article 1 This regulation is established to give basis for evaluating student conduct.
- Article 2 The student conduct base score is 85. The full score is 95. Any student receiving a score above 95 will be given an honorary award by the president.
- Article 3 Students receive conduct scores in 5 categories:
 - A for score above 90 to 95.
 - B for score above 80 to 89.
 - C for score above 70 to 79.
 - D for score above 60 to 69.
 - F for score under 60, which is a failing score.
- Article 4 Student conduct will be evaluated once every semester. Student conduct scores are given based on their school records including records of absence, awards, sanctions and other items. (Determined by the Office of Student Affairs)
- Article 5 Awards and sanctions will be added to or deducted from the conduct score according to the following rules:
 - 1 added point for 1 citation; 2.5 added points for 1 commendation; 7.5 added points for 1 merit.
 - 1 deducted point for 1 warning; 2.5 deducted points for 1 reprimand; 7.5 deducted points for 1 demerit.
- Article 6 Faculty members and divisions in the university have the authority to give recommendations for awards and sanctions but have to follow NCHU Student Awards and Sanctions Regulations.
- Article 7 The Division of Student Life of Office of Student Affairs should make a report on students in bachelor's program who get full conduct scores or who fail the conduct evaluation.

- Article 8 Student conduct score of students in bachelor's program should be approved by the head of the Office of Student Affairs.
- Article 9 After evaluation, student conduct score of students in bachelor's program will be submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs and be sent to the students' parents or guardians along with other documents.
- Article 10 The regulations shall be implemented after being approved by the Student Affairs Meeting and authorized by the President. Any amendments shall be processed accordingly.
