- 一、凡國內大學或大學校院之大學部應屆畢業生，品學特優者，每一學院得推薦應屆畢業生人數百分之一，為本會榮譽會員，不足一人者以一人計。應屆畢業生會員推薦資格，以應屆畢業生學期前各學期成績平均為準。

I. Each college of domestic universities or colleges may recommend up to 1% of undergraduate graduands that are excellent in academic performance as well as moral conduct to receive the honorary membership of the Society. The number of recommended graduands shall be rounded up to the next integer if the number is less than one. The recommendation criteria are subject to the average of semester grades prior to the semester of graduation.

- 二、凡國內大學或大學校院之大學部應屆碩士畢業生，品學兼優者，每一學院得推薦應屆畢業生人數百分之三，為本會榮譽會員，不足一人者以一人計。

II. Each college of domestic universities or colleges may recommend up to 3% of master's graduands that are excellent in academic performance as well as moral conduct to receive the honorary membership of the Society. The number of recommended graduands shall be rounded up to the next integer if the number is less than one.

- 三、凡國內大學或大學校院之大學部應屆博士畢業生品學兼優者，得推薦應屆畢業生人數百分之十，為本會榮譽會員，不足一人者以一人計。

III. Each college of domestic universities or colleges may recommend up to 10% of doctoral graduands that are excellent in academic performance as well as moral conduct to receive the honorary membership of the Society. The number of recommended graduands shall be rounded up to the next integer if the number is less than one.

- 四、凡校院或研究所之學生於畢業後，對學術研究或社會事業有特優貢獻者，每校每年得於畢業生中推薦一人至三人為本會榮譽會員。

IV. Every year domestic universities or colleges may recommend one to three alumni who have had significant contributions to academic research or social

undertakings to receive the honorary membership of the Society.
