NCHU Student Guidelines for Applying Emergency Assistance Grant

- 1. The present Guidelines are formulated in accordance with the "NCHU Student Guidelines for Applying Emergency Assistance Grant" to assist students having serious financial problem owing to family or personal incidents or difficulties.
- 2. A student can apply for the grant in accordance with the presen Guidelines under the following conditions:
 - (1)Hospitalization owing to injury or illness and incapability of paying the medical expenditure because of family financial difficulties.
 - (2)One's life is in trouble because his/her family encounters an unexpected change.
 - (3)Student Death.
 - (4)Unexpected incidences that require aid.
- 3. The application form along with relevant documents should be submitted by the student or his/her advisor and approved by the department head and college dean. The application will be reviewed by the Division of Student Life and approved by NCHU President.
- 4. The maximal grant is NT\$ 30,000 and can be applied only once.
- 5. The source for the grant is the "Student Study Financial Support" comprised in the Office of Student Affairs budgets.
- 6. The present Guidelines and any amendments shall be implemented after being passed by Student Affairs Meeting and approved by NCHU President.
