\*Rehearsal process: On-stage clothing appearance and precautions  $\rightarrow$  The emcee calls the roll  $\rightarrow$  Go on stage to practice awarding and taking photos (please pay attention to the

movements and position of the previous student when taking

the stage).

## OPlease be on time and attend the "Graduation Ceremony"

- \*Check-in time: Saturday, June 1, 8:20 a.m.
- \*Check-in location: There is a sign-in table in front of the ceremony stage of HuiSun Hall. After signing in, please take your seat according to the seat label.
- \*Note: Please wear formal attire, academic gown, and academic cap throughout the ceremony to participate in the ceremony, and do not leave midway.

(Please keep smiling and be calm when taking the stage)

- \*Attire: Please wear an academic gown and formal attire (no sandals or slippers).
- \*After taking the stage: Locate the location of the drill → The principal and other first-level supervisors issue certificates and honorary ribbons → Listen to the students in the queue and salute the principal → Turn right and step off the stage in order. (The entire award ceremony will be broadcast live)

- \*On the day of the ceremony, we asked the photography club to take photos with the principal and dean. Please do not take photos on-site. Photos are expected to be available for viewing and download on the NCHU OSA website on Monday 12 June.
